

THE PARKWAY

(FORMERLY KNOWN AS EDWARDSVILLE TOWN CENTER)



Construction commenced in early June on a \$50MM mixed use development at the intersection of Governors Parkway and Route 157 in Edwardsville, Illinois. The 26-acre development on the site of the former Madison Mutual Insurance Company headquarters will consist of six out lots, three mixed use residential buildings, single story retail buildings and a new 40,000 square foot flag ship store for Kloss Furniture. The project will include approximately 78,000 square feet of leasable commercial retail space. The Trace will make up the residential portion of the complex, consisting of 184 luxury apartments units and will be a mix of one, two and three -bedroom units. The project will include multiple amenities including a resort style pool, social lounge, walking/ jogging paths and connections to the Madison County Bike and Walking trail system. "The Parkway" vision will bring an urban lifestyle development to





Edwardsville and the surrounding communities that combines the convenience of a downtown with the feel of a neighborhood.



NEW PUMP STATION—BEARDSTOWN, IL

Construction of a sheet piling pump structure with associated piping systems that includes the installation of three 40,000 gallon per minute pumps on the Illinois River. Sheet pile installation began in early October and the new pump station will be operational by June 2019. Installation of the sheet pile structure included constructing the base concrete mat 25' below river water elevations.

CERRO GORDO CUSD #100 SCHOOL ADDITION & RENOVATIONS



Construction commenced in February on a new 20,000 SF addition to Cerro Gordo junior/senior high school that will connect the existing building to the circa 1963 gymnasium on the other side of the parking lot creating one secure entrance. The new addition includes additional classrooms, a STEM area, and a new library. Renovations of the existing school building to the North, circa 1929, include transforming the old gymnasium into an auditorium and adding an elevator for accessibility. The phasing and coordination of this project is critical as the majority of the renovation work revolves around completion of the

new addition to allow the existing school work to be completed in the summer of 2019.




METROPOLITAN ST. LOUIS SEWER DISTRICT PROJECTS

Coldwater Creek WWTF Final Clarifier Replacement: Decommissioning and demolition of the four oldest clarifiers at the plant to be replaced by a single clarifier with the capacity large enough to handle the increasing demand on the plant. Along with the clarifier upgrade multiple flow meters/piping will also be renovated to increase the available flow volume. Plant operations must stay in operation 24 hours a day so communication and coordination with the plant is key to stagger shutdowns during low flow timeframes.

Grand Glaize WWTF: Electrical service upgrade to run 2,200 LF of new ductbanks to many of the facilities in the plant. Most of the upgrades require routing around existing and poorly identified utilities. The scope also includes removing and replacing existing MCC's and constructing a new electrical room addition to house the new MCC's and upgraded control equipment.

Gravois Trunk Sanitary Storage Facility: Construction of two 4.0 million gallon wire-wound, prestressed concrete tanks in Crestwood, Missouri. The \$24MM project is slated to commence in early 2019 with completion in mid 2020.


